Entry Fee - \$10 per Class Must have 3 entries per class

Rules

- You must be 18 years or older to enter the contest.
- Required to sign paper stating the White County Fair Association and Sponsors are not responsible in case of an accident.
- Only contest participants and judges in the competition sawing area.
- Everyone must wear eye protection.
- Earplugs or earmuffs are optional
- Chaps are preferred, but not required.
- Your time will start when the chain touches the log and stops when the chain comes out of the log.
- You must have a clean cut, and the block must fall off or you will be disqualified.
- If the chain comes off saw, you have a 5 minute time limit to repair.
- If chain saw stalls, you have a 5 minute time limit to restart. Restart will be a New/Fresh cut.
- The Winning Chainsaw will not be able to move up to the next class.
- Two different participants may not run on the same chainsaw in a class.
- The judges decision is final.

Class 1

All participants will use the provided cross cut saw Classes 2-9

All modifications are legal except racing pipes. You can run any kind of fuel you choose.

Class 10

Chain saw bar 16" min. or 20" max.

No competition saw chains or skip tooth chains.

No fuel in chainsaw, standard 50:1 fuel will be provided for each participant. No competition saw.

Class 11

All participants will use the same saw.
