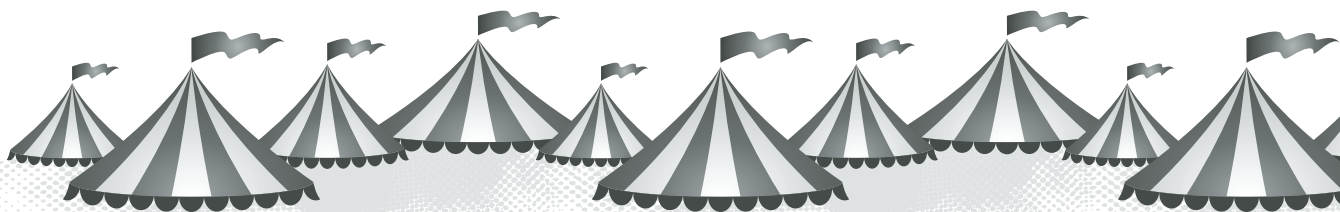

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## WHITE COUNTY AGRICULTURE FAIR RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR EXHIBITS AND EVENTS

1. Competition is open to the people as stated in each event.
2. Every animal and article entered for exhibition shall be under the control of the Superintendent, and while every precaution will be taken to prevent damage or loss, the Superintendents will not be responsible in any case for damage, accident or loss that may occur.
3. The White County Fair Association will not be responsible for any personal injury or property damage of any kind whatsoever received on the Fair Ground on in connection with the Fair.
4. The Superintendent of each department shall have supervision and control of all exhibits during the duration of the Fair.
5. No names, marks or other identification of ownership will be allowed on anything except canned goods, until after the premiums are awarded.
6. All premiums will be awarded as follows: First - Blue Ribbon; Second—Red Ribbon; Third - White Ribbon
7. With the exception of Livestock and Poultry, only one entry will be allowed in any lot from the individual or family.
8. Where all entries in any class belong to the same individual, in Livestock and Poultry, only (2) two monies will be paid, although he may enter as many animals as he desires.
9. No person will be allowed to exhibit products in any other person's name.
10. Premiums will be allowed only on articles named in the catalog.
11. No article or animal deemed unworthy will be awarded premiums.
12. Superintendent of Stalls is in charge of housing of all livestock.
13. The Fair Management reserve the right to cancel, any or all classes because of excessive weather, fire or any other calamity over which we have no control.
14. All Poultry are to stay on the Fair Grounds until 1:00 p.m.,

Sunday, otherwise prizes will be voided.

15. Each Superintendent is responsible for acquiring someone to take entries in his/her department and being sure that the entry books or lists are turned in to the office immediately following their show. These records are required by our auditors and it is important we comply with this requirement.
16. If you need supplies for your department please let us know now so we can have them available for you to get your show started on time.
17. An admission will be charged.
18. All exhibits are to remain through 1:00 p.m., Sunday.

### STATE AID FOR FAIRS

"From the funds appropriated by the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee for the purpose of aiding agricultural fairs in the payment of agricultural premiums, the White County Fair Association has been allotted its proportionate share by the Tennessee Department of Agricultural." "For the purpose of further encouraging fairs to excel in their usefulness to their respective areas, a Merit Award provision was also made in the appropriation. It is hoped that White County Fair can have an exhibition sufficiently creditable to warrant its receiving one of the special Merit Awards in addition to its allotment of State Aid."

3. Honey for competition must be from the participant’s personal hives and produced in the fall of 2020 or spring/summer 2021 and presented for display in a 1 lb. Queen Line honey jar with a 1 piece metal or plastic lid.
4. Honey will be judged according to official score cards. An unjudged card will be available for review of qualifications and criteria at registration.
5. Contestants will not be allowed to witness judging. No judge

shall be present at registration or enter honey to be judged.

6. Frames of honey will be displayed in sanitary bee-proof containers furnished by the fair-association and provided by the Mountain Valley Beekeepers Association.
7. Beeswax must be from the participant’s personal hives and produced in the fall of 2020 or spring/summer of 2021.
8. Baking with Honey – (Honey is the only sweetener to be used) – no sugars to be used – no package mixes, - cannot use bread machines – must submit recipe. Recipe shall remain confidential.
9. Photographs – any size up to 8”x10” and taken in the fall of 2020 or spring/summer 2021. Must pertain to beekeeping.
10. All exhibits must be entered from 8:00 A.M. – 12:00 P.M. Saturday, August 28th. Judging will be at 1:00 P.M. Saturday, August 28th. Checkout is Sunday, September 5th from 1-3.

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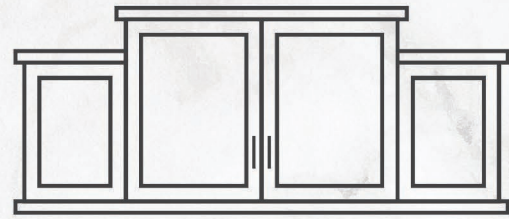


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
