Hunter Award Rules:

OPEN SHOW AFFILIATED WITH THE NATIONAL WALKING HORSE ASSOCIATION COMMITTEE

The J.B. Hunter Memorial Trophy is presented by Dr. Charles A. Mitchell to encourage excellence in Youth Horsemanship. Trophy will be awarded to the youth who scores the most horsemanship points during the County Night Show only. Points will be awarded as follows in designated Classes. Designated Classes are identified with an *

1st Place.....	Five (5) Points
2nd Place.....	Four (4) Points
3rd Place.....	Three (3) Points
4th Place.....	Two (2) Points
5th Place.....	One (1) Point

In the event of a tie, a selected committee will determine the winner based upon Sportsmanship. All horses must be County owned, and points may be accumulated from the White County Walking Horse Show and the Pony Show the same night. The Trophy will be awarded on Saturday night. A Sportsmanship award will be given to the youth who exhibits the most enthusiasm and sportsmanship during the Pony Show and County Horse Show.
