Rules:

1. All entrants to the Baby Pageant must be actual residents and reside in White County, Tennessee. An actual resident is defined as an individual living on property assessed to White County.
2. The deadline for entering this pageant is August 15, 2026. Applications available at the White County Agricultural Complex on Saturday, August 8 or Saturday, August 15 from 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 Noon. A \$20.00 entry fee (cash) will be due along with the completed application. Online registration begins August 8, 2026, and will close August 15, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. Online registration at www.whitecountyagfair.com/forms.
3. Each contestant must be the appropriate age of her category on AUGUST 15, 2026.
4. Parent or Guardian must accompany child on stage. Optional for ages 3-4 and 5-6 years.
5. All entries of the Baby Pageant must be at the White County Agricultural Complex Building on Saturday, August 22, 2026.
6. No fake hair, teeth or excessive make-up.
7. Judging will be based on: Dress, Personality, Smile, Hair and Stage presence.
8. Judges will be residents from out-of-town and no relation to contestants.

Rules:

1. All entrants must be an actual resident in White County, Tennessee. Actual resident is defined as an individual living on a property assessed to White County Tax Assessor's office. In cases of joint custody, one parent/guardian must be a White County Resident and the contestant must attend or be zoned for a White County School in order to qualify for pageant entry. Proof may be required.
2. Any former queen of a White County Fair Pageant may not compete in the same age category as previously won.
3. Deadline to enter is 5:00 p.m. online on August 15, 2026. Applications will be available at the White County Agricultural Complex on Saturday, August 8th and Saturday, August 15th from 8:30 a.m. to 12 noon. Entry online is also available from August 8th until 5:00 p.m. on August 15th by going to www.whitecountyagfair.com/forms.
4. A non-refundable \$20 cash entry fee will be due along with the completed application.
5. Fairest Little Miss Contestants must have reached her 7th birthday, but not her 10th birthday by August 15, 2026.
6. Fairest Junior Miss Contestants must have reached her 10th birthday, but not her 13th birthday by August 15, 2026.
7. Fair Princess contestants must have reached her 13th birthday, but not her 16th birthday by August 15, 2026.
8. Fairest of the Fair contestants must have reached her 16th birthday by August 15, 2026. She cannot have reached her 21st birthday on or before December 31, 2026.

Fairest of the Fair Rules:

1. A contestant cannot qualify if she has ever been married, had a child, or been found guilty of a felony.
2. Contestant must be originally and currently of the female gender.
3. Dresses must be formal and must be floor-length. No exposed midriff. No visible body piercing other than ears and no visible tattoos. This is a low to semi-glitz pageant. Makeup is allowed, but must be appropriate. Absolutely No Flippers.
4. Contestants will be judged: on beauty, poise, and personality.
5. The White County Fair Association will not be responsible for lost or stolen articles, damages to apparel or accessories, or bodily injury incurred by a contestant during the pageant or pageant activities.
6. Contestants may compete in State Competition one time only.
7. The Fairest of the Fair must be accompanied by a parent/legal guardian who will serve as a chaperone at the State pageant.
8. All regulations of State Pageant apply to local Fairest of the Fair Pageant.
9. Winner is required to be present for other Fair Events through out the week, when requested.
10. Any criminal history will be grounds for disqualification.
11. Disrespectful comments on social media of any kind regarding this event or a contestant will be grounds for disqualification.
12. Reigning winners cannot compete in another fair pageant the same year they are crowning a new winner.
13. By signing and turning in your application you are agreeing to all these rules and regulations and you understand everything listed above.

The winner of the state-wide contest will receive the title “Tennessee’s Fairest of the Fairs” and will receive such prizes as approved by the Association.

FAIREST OF THE FAIR PAGEANT SCHOLARSHIP
 The Fairest of the Fair Pageant Winner will be eligible for a college or university scholarship within the State of Tennessee. The following criteria will be followed in awarding the scholarship each year:

1. The amount of the scholarship will be \$1,000.
2. One-half of the amount (\$500.) will be issued upon completion of the first semester's work. The second half will be issued upon completion of the second semester's work. The recipient must produce documents of being enrolled and having a 3.0 or higher GPA. Needs to be acquired first semester upon entrance.
3. In the event the winner is not ready to enter their post-secondary education institution, the scholarship can be claimed within one year of their High School graduation.
4. If the winner of the Fairest of the Fair pageant does not plan to enter a post-secondary educational institution, then the scholarship will be forfeited.

The Runner-Up is NOT eligible for this award.
