- All entrants must be an actual resident and domiciled in White County, Tennessee. Actual resident is defined as an individual living on a property assessed to White County Tax Assessor's office. In cases of joint custody, one parent/guardian must be a White County Resident and the contestant must attend a White County School in order to qualify for pageant entry. Proof may be required.
- Deadline to enter is Noon on August 26, 2023. Applications
 will be available at the White County Agricultural Complex on
 Saturday August 19th and Saturday August 26th from 8:30 a.m.
 to 12 noon. Entry online is also available from August 19th
 until noon August 26th by going to
 www.whitecountyagfair.org.
- A non-refundable \$10 cash entry fee will be due along with the completed application.
- Fairest Little Miss Contestants must have reached her 7th birthday, but not her 10th birthday by August 26, 2023.
- Fairest Junior Miss Contestants must have reached her 20th birthday, but not her 13th birthday by August 16, 2023.
- Fair Princess contestants must have reached her 13th birthday, but not her 16th birthday by August 26, 2023.
- Fairest of the Fair contestants must have reached her 16th birthday by August 26, 2023. She cannot have reached her 21st birthday on or before December 31, 2023.

Little Miss: Dresses may be one or two pieces with Absolutely No midriff showing. Dresses can be any length.

Junior Miss, Fair Princess, and Fairest of The Fair:

•Dresses may be one or two pieces with Absolutely NO midriff showing. Dresses Must be floor length.

The Categories will not start before the scheduled time, but they are not guaranteed to start at the times listed below

Little Miss-5:30pm Junior Miss-6:30 pm Fair Princess-7:30 pm Fairest of The Fair-8:30 pm

Please arrive at least 30 minutes early to Check-in and vote for Miss Congeniality

Rules:

- 1. A contestant cannot qualify if she has ever been married, had a child, or been found guilty of a felony.
- 2. Contestant must be originally and currently of the female gender.
- 3. Dresses must be formal and must be floor-length. No exposed midriff. No visible body piercing other than ears and no visible tattoos. This is a low to semi-glitz pageant. Makeup is allowed, but must be appropriate. Absolutely No Flippers.
- 4. Contestants will be judged: on beauty, poise, and personality.
- 5. The White County Fair Association will not be responsible for lost or stolen articles, damages to apparel or accessories, or bodily injury incurred by a contestant during the pageant or pageant activities.
- Contestants may compete in State Competition one time only.
- 7. All regulations of State Pageant apply to local Fairest of the Fair Pageant.
- 8. Winner is required to be present for other Fair Events through out the week, when requested.
- 9. Any criminal history will be grounds for disqualification.
- 10. Disrespectful comments on social media of any kind regarding this event or a contestant will be grounds for disqualification.
- 11. Reigning winners cannot compete in another fair pageant the same year they are crowning a new winner.
- 12. By signing and turning in your application you are agreeing to all these rules and regulations and you understand everything listed above.

Their decision will be final. Exact time and place of each event pertaining to the pageants will be announced by the Superintendents of the pageants. Winners and runners-up will have certain duties to perform throughout the week of the Fair.

FAIREST OF THE FAIR PAGEANT SCHOLARSHIP

The Fairest of the Fair Pageant Winner will be eligible for a college or university scholarship within the State of Tennessee.

The following criteria will be followed in awarding the scholarship each year:

- 1. The amount of the scholarship will be \$1,000.
- 2. One-half of the amount (\$500.) will be issued upon completion of the first semester's work. The second half will be issues upon completion of the second semester's work. The recipient must produce documents of being enrolled and having a 3.0 or higher GPA. Needs to be acquired first semester upon entrance.
- 3. In the event the winner is not ready to enter college, having not in the bank account and when she is ready to enter college, it will be issued in the above manner without accrued interest. Upon completion of High School, winner must enter college during the following Fall Semester.
- 4. If the winner of the Fairest of the Fair pageant does not plan to enter college, then the scholarship will be forfeited.

The Runner-Up is NOT eligible for this award.
